Ocean Sport Fishing Regulations Update for September 13, 2004

The purpose of this document is to notify California's saltwater sport fishermen of upcoming regulation changes, including seasonal openings and closures, bag and size limit changes, depth and gear restriction changes, etc.

Ocean Salmon

The sport fishery for ocean salmon (*Oncorhynchus* spp.) from **Humboldt Mountain (OR) to Horse Mountain (Humboldt county)** will close on September 13, 2004. The 2005 ocean salmon season will be decided in April by the [Pacific Fishery Management Council](#) and the [California Fish and Game Commission](#).

The sport fishery for ocean salmon from **Horse Mountain (Humboldt county) to Point Arena (Mendocino county)** will remain open through November 14, 2004.

The sport fishery for ocean salmon from **Point Arena (Mendocino county) to Pigeon Point (San Mateo county)** will remain open through November 14, 2004.

The sport fishery for ocean salmon from **Pigeon Point (San Mateo county) to the Mexico border** will remain open through October 3, 2004.
